



## Criteria for Meetings/Courses suitable for C-QulP Recertification

For a course to be C-QulP approved, it must consist of at least one complete day (5 hours or more) on issues relevant to colposcopy and its practice in Australia and New Zealand.

The course can be approved if it is part of a wider course or conference and a complete day or time equivalent is devoted to colposcopy.

Subjects to be covered should be relevant and/or controversial.

Suggested topics include:

- Guidance on national guidelines
- Results of recent research in relation to cervical screening or colposcopy
- Audit in relation to cervical screening or colposcopy
- Data collection/QA/bench marking in relation to cervical screening or colposcopy
- Multidisciplinary sessions of education and/or training in relation to cervical screening or colposcopy.

Cytology and pathology when relevant to colposcopy and colposcopy practice.

Management of invasive disease can be included but should be limited to early invasive disease.
