

DRANZCOG Advanced Summative Assessment

Instructions for completing the Summative Assessment

Overview

The Summative Assessment is completed by the Training Supervisor(s) to assess the performance of the Trainee against standard domains and criteria to verify their ability to practice obstetrics independently at the end of the DRANZCOG Advanced Training program.

The Summative Assessment is an assessment *requirement* for Trainees who commenced training on or after 1st January 2017.

The assessment should be undertaken when the Trainee is in the last months of DRANZCOG Advanced Training.

Completing the form

Training Supervisors must complete the Summative Assessment for each of the assessment criteria and confirm whether the Trainee is able to perform at the level expected to practice obstetrics independently at the end of the DRANZCOG Advanced Training Program.

The assessment should be supported with feedback comments and include acknowledgment of the Trainees readiness to enrol on the register of Advanced Diplomates.

Both the Training Supervisors and Trainee must sign and date the Summative Assessment.

The completed Summative Assessment should be submitted to the College with the final logbook at the completion of the DRANZCOG Advanced Training program.

If any criteria are assessed as *below* the level expected to practice obstetrics independently at the end of the DRANZCOG Advanced Training Program the Trainee does not pass the Summative Assessment

Trainee Support

In the event the Trainee does not pass the Summative Assessment the Training Supervisor may recommend remediation and support a further period of Supervised Training.

If further Supervised Training is required an action plan to address the areas needing further development should be discussed and implemented.
