



## Key attribute categories from three- and six-monthly reports

### Clinical experience

- Demonstrates responsibility, reliability and initiative in undertaking clinical and other duties and follow-up.
- Manages clinical load effectively in consultation with other members of the health care team.
- Demonstrates obstetric clinical procedural and surgical skills.
- Demonstrates obstetric non-procedural skills.
- Demonstrates gynaecological clinical procedural and surgical skills.
- Demonstrates gynaecological non-procedural skills.
- Demonstrates appropriate documentation and organisational skills.
- Demonstrates continued improvement in medical expertise, clinical reasoning and judgment.

### Academic abilities

- Demonstrates appropriate theoretical knowledge of specialty and principles of evidence-based medicine.
- Demonstrates teaching at both undergraduate and postgraduate level.
- Demonstrates attendance and participation at continuing education meetings.

### Professional qualities

- Communicates effectively with patients and their families.
- Relates appropriately and communicates effectively with other members of the health care team.
- Accepts constructive feedback.
- Reviews and updates professional practice.
