The RANZCOG CMFM regulations require that:

“Trainees will be expected to provide evidence of having taken, and successfully completed, an approved assessable course in biostatistics offered by a tertiary institution. Trainees are required to submit details of the course proposed prior to commencing it.”

An acceptable course will cover

- epidemiology and biostatistics and
- involve instruction for at least Three (3) hours a week for ONE (1) semester (CMFM 2020 Handbook v2 Page 12 of 67).

Please note that this list was current in May 2020, and its content, and whether or not it will still be offered, and their format and contents may vary with each academic year. It is the responsibility of the CMFM trainee seeking approval of the course to ensure that the course still complies with the RANZCOG regulations prior to the CMFM board submitting for approval.
