



#### GLYN WHITE RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP - CONDITIONS

*The Glyn White Research Fellowship was founded in 1989 in memory of the late J Glyn White, CBE, Fellow ad eundem FRACOG, a specialist in neonatal paediatrics. The Fellowship is financed with monies from the William Angliss Charitable Trust.*

#### **Purpose**

To promote research in perinatal medicine.

#### **Eligibility**

The Fellowship is open to graduates in medicine or science, within five (5) years of the award of a Masters or PhD, who preferably have had some involvement in medical research in Australia and/or overseas.

The applicant must be an Australian citizen.

The Fellowship is tenable only in Victoria and only at approved teaching hospitals.

The Fellowship may not be used for any activity involved in or associated with embryonic research.

#### **Tenure**

Two (2) years, conditional upon the approval of a progress report six (6) months into the Fellowship.

#### **Fellowship Funds**

AUD\$30,000 per annum (\$60,000 in total).

#### **Applications**

Applications are to be submitted using the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RANZCOG) Women's Health Foundation Application Form (Research-Based), together with other information as specified on that form.

The date for receipt of applications is 30 June.

Applications are assessed by the RANZCOG Research Grants Committee (RGC).

#### **Administration**

The Fellowship is to be undertaken in a hospital, university department or research institute in Victoria.

Time spent undertaking the Research Fellowship may be recognised for part of the pre-Fellowship training for FRANZCOG, or towards the Continuing Professional Development (CPD) program requirements of the College for Fellows.

## Reporting

Scholarship recipients must submit the following reports to the RANZCOG Women's Health Foundation for review by the RGC:

Each must be submitted on the form(s) provided and include a letter of endorsement from the Research Project Supervisor.

### Progress Report

- Due six (6) months into the project (i.e. normally by 31 July)
- Must be approved by the RGC prior to confirmation of the second year of the Fellowship.

### Final Report

- Due by 31 January in the year following completion of the project (unless otherwise stipulated).
- Must include a Summary Report (maximum 200 words), which provides a lay summary of the research project undertaken. This may be considered for publication in *O&G* magazine and may also be used for other promotional purposes by RANZCOG.

## Acknowledgement

The RANZCOG Women's Health Foundation is to be acknowledged in any publication or thesis resulting from work undertaken during the tenure of the Fellowship by stating that the author was the recipient of the Glyn White Research Fellowship for a particular period.

A copy of any published article arising from research carried out under the Glyn White Research Fellowship is to be submitted to the Foundation when available.

## Promotion

RANZCOG may publish details of the Fellowship recipient and the associated research project, including the Summary Report, for promotional, educational, or membership activities in all forms of media now known or later developed, including but not limited to, the RANZCOG website, Facebook, Twitter, advertising, presentations, and marketing materials.
