Introduction

The Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RANZCOG) has a long history of supporting women's health in the Pacific. RANZCOG's commitment was reaffirmed in 2017 with the launch of *Improving Women's Health in the Pacific*, a publication that advocated for engagement, advocacy and practical support to empower the reproductive health workforce in Pacific Island countries. Accordingly, RANZCOG's global health activities are focused on the support of O&G training and education of Pacific O&G clinicians, often undertaken collaboratively with local, regional and international partners.

Global Health Action Plan 2023-2024

RANZCOG's current global health objective, as outlined in the RANZCOG Strategic Plan for 2022-2024, is to *build capacity of the O&G workforce in Pacific Island countries through support for training, education and research*. This Global Health Action Plan details the activities and initiatives, both current and proposed, that RANZCOG will undertake to achieve this objective. These activities are categorised under four priority areas:

1. Organisational capacity
2. Partnerships
3. Support for training, education and research
4. Advocacy and communication
