

RANZCOG members and trainees contribute to women's health around the world, having worked or continuing to work in **50** countries outside of Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand. Global women's health has been supported via:

- **Capacity building**

- Teaching and mentoring of local O&G consultants and surgeons around gynaecological surgery (general, fistula, prolapse)
- Teaching general doctors, midwives, nurses and other healthcare workers
- Delivering workshops, including train the trainer, ultrasound, perineal trauma, obstetric emergencies, neonatal resuscitation
- Supporting training and assessment of O&G registrars and medical students

- **Clinical O&G care**

- General obstetrics and gynaecology, including clinics, gynaecological surgery
- Locum support for local O&G consultants

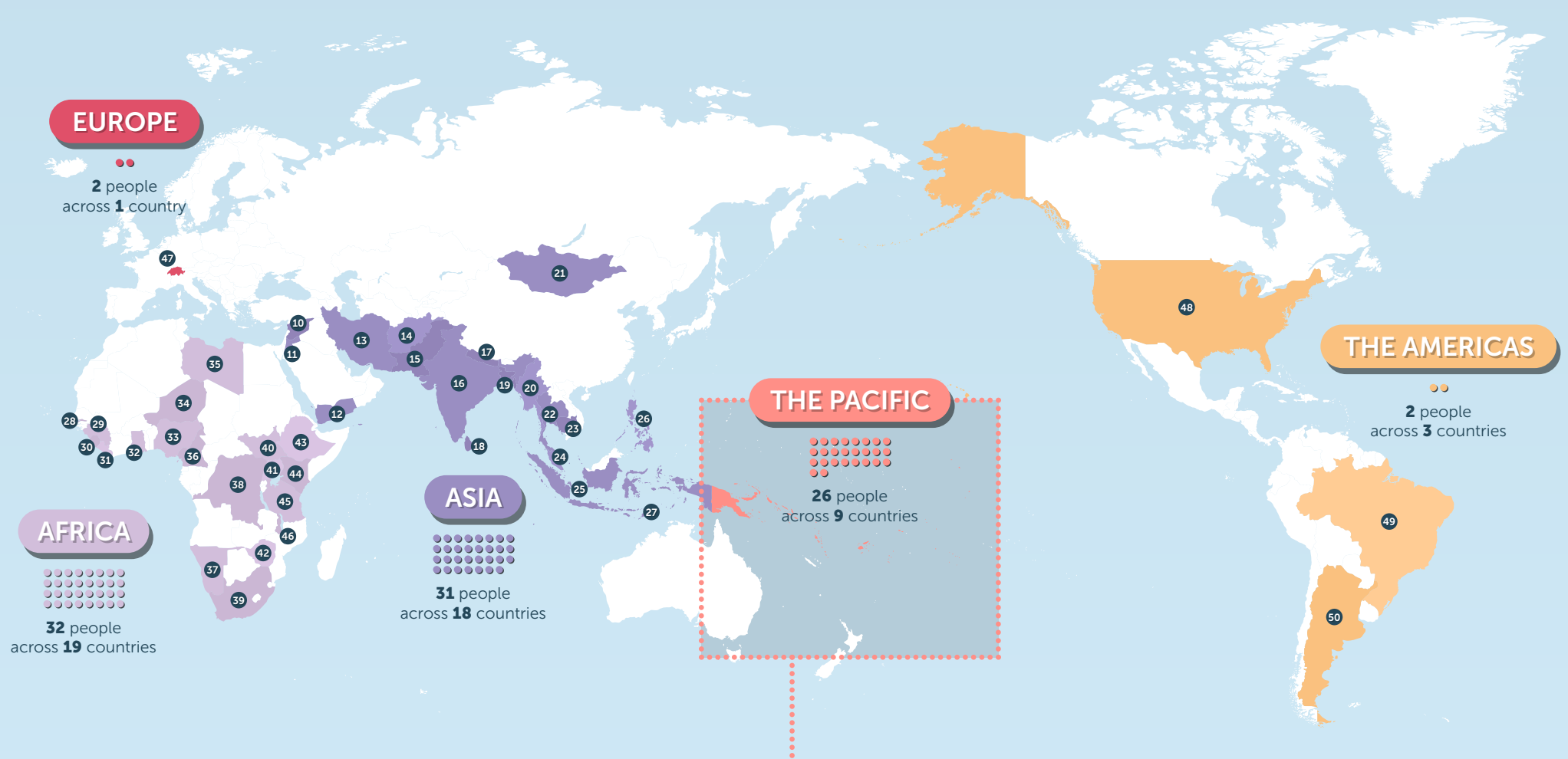
- **Screening**

- Human papillomavirus (HPV), cervical dysplasia

- **Health promotion and community projects targeting girls and young women**

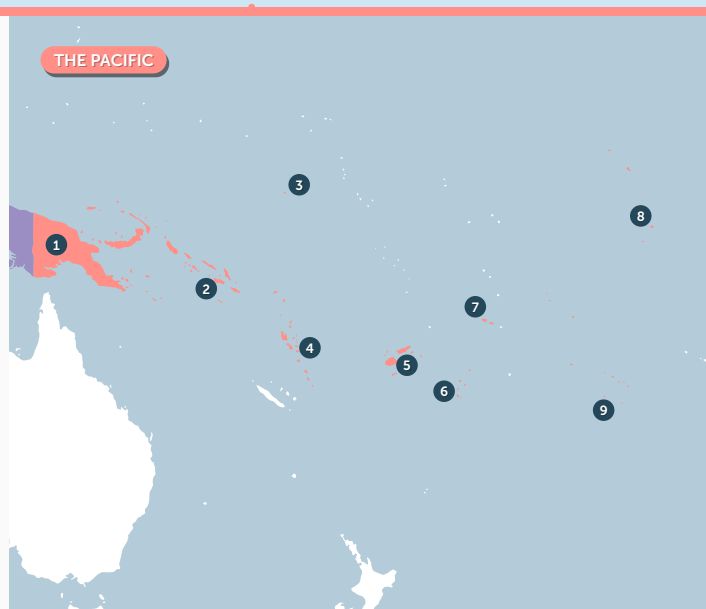
- **Guideline development for pregnancy and postpartum care in resource-poor settings, perinatal deaths**

RANZCOG aims to build O&G workforce capacity in Pacific Island countries via support for training, education and support. It achieves this through:

- Awarding scholarships to attend RANZCOG events in Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand to Pacific O&G clinicians
- Offering Associate Membership of RANZCOG to Pacific O&G specialists. RANZCOG has 65 Pacific Associate Members from 11 Pacific Island countries (American Samoa, Cook Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Fiji, Kiribati, Palau, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Solomon Islands, Tonga, Vanuatu)
- Providing Pacific Associate Members and O&G trainees with access to RANZCOG resources
- Awarding Academic Fellowships to newly-appointed academics at University of PNG and Fiji National University
- Collaboration with local, regional and international partners
- Financial support for Pacific Society for Reproductive Health, an NGO dedicated to Pacific women's health
- Advocacy on Pacific women's health issues
- The RANZCOG Global Health Action Plan 2023-2024 details the College's activities, current and proposed, to support O&G capacity in the Pacific
- In addition to RANZCOG's support for women's health in the Pacific, 26 College members and trainees have also worked and/or continue to work in 9 Pacific Islands countries, including Cook Islands, Fiji, Kiribati, Nauru, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Solomon Islands, Tonga, Vanuatu
