RANZCOG members and trainees contribute to women's health around the world, having worked or continuing to work in **50** countries outside of Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand. Global women's health has been supported via:

- Capacity building
 - Teaching and mentoring of local O&G consultants and surgeons around gynaecological surgery (general, fistula, prolapse)
 - Teaching general doctors, midwives, nurses and other healthcare workers
 - Delivering workshops, including train the trainer, ultrasound, perineal trauma, obstetric emergencies, neonatal resuscitation
 - Supporting training and assessment of O&G registrars and medical students
- Clinical O&G care
 - General obstetrics and gynaecology, including clinics, gynaecological surgery
 - Locum support for local O&G consultants

- Screening
 - Human papillomavirus (HPV), cervical dysplasia
- Health promotion and community projects targeting girls and young women
- Guideline development for pregnancy and postpartum care in resource-poor settings, perinatal deaths
