- Locum support for local O&G consultants

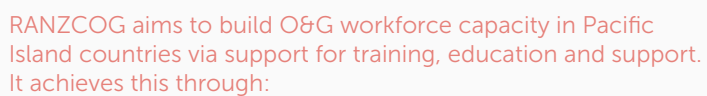
- Screening
